Subject: Submission of Documents for Paperless Entries Overridden for Review or Examination by the Los Angeles/Long Beach Seaport

CORRECTION: The email addresses provided in the original bulletin were incorrect. This issuance provides the correct email addresses (see page 2, paragraph 1).

PURPOSE:

This is to remind the importing community of current procedural requirements when entries designated as “paperless” in the ACS/ABI Selectivity system are overridden for review and/or exam by Customs and Border Protection (CBP) at the Los Angeles/Long Beach Seaport.

BACKGROUND:

CBP is responsible for ensuring the accuracy and integrity of the paperless entry program. To accomplish this requirement, a percentage of paperless entries are selected for examination and verification by the seaport Trade Sections. The following procedures have been developed to meet CBP objectives while minimizing disruption of the normal flow of cargo.

ACTION:

When a paperless entry is overridden for review or examination, the CBP Officer generating the override will contact the broker/filer with instructions regarding the submission of the entry documents. Please be sure to follow the instructions of the officer and send the entry to the proper location in order to avoid delays in securing the release of the cargo. Claims by the broker or cargo facility that the cargo has been delivered prior to notification of the override must be supported by documentation and will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

Entry documents for paperless entries selected for review/examination at the Seaport must be presented with the attached “Paperless Entry Override” coversheet.

The entries will be reviewed by the officer/team responsible for the override. If it is determined that an exam is required, a courtesy copy (if provided by the broker) of the 3461 will be placed in the broker box advising them of the exam. If it is determined that no exam will be conducted, the entry will be closed in ACS, the CBP 3461 will be signed off, and the entry packet will be returned to the broker box.
