

Basic Factors to Properly Apply Traiff Classification to Fabric

1. Fiber Content (ie: 70% Cotton, 30% Polyester)
2. Grams per Square Meter

A. Please complete the following if fabric is WOVEN:

1. Circle One: Made with **Man Made filaments** or **Man Made Staple Fibers**
2. Circle One: Type of Weave is **Plain - Sateen - Twill - Oxford - Dobby - Broadcloth Poplin - Fancy - Jacquard** (woven on jacquard looms) YES / NO
3. Circle one: **Bleached - Unbleached - Dyed - Printed - Yarns of Different Colors**

For Filament Yarns Specify also: (Circle One)

- A. Textured or Non-Textured
- B. High Tenacity or Not High Tenacity

If woven Wool fabric: (circle one) COMBED or CARDED

B. Please complete the following if fabric is KNIT:

1. Circle One if fabric is Pile: **Long Pile - Looped Pile - Other**
2. Circle One if fabric is Less Than **30 cm** in width: **Lace - Other**
