U.S. Single Window for Trade



INTERNATIONAL TRADE

- In FY 2014, CBP processed more than \$2.4 trillion in trade – an increase of more than four percent from 2013 – and more than 25.7 million cargo containers, up 4.5 percent from the previous year.

ACE / ITDS

- Executive Order establishes deadline of December 2016 for implementation
- ACE is the technology enabler through which Single Window processing will be achieved
- Key features to enable Single Window processing have been implemented

PARTNER GOVERNMENT AGENCIES

- 47 Partner Government Agencies
- Largely paper-based with multiple entry systems
- Nearly 200 forms required for imports and exports



Quicker data availability for Government - better identification of dangerous or prohibited shipments



Automated Agency interactions reduce paper, enable near-real time decision making by Government

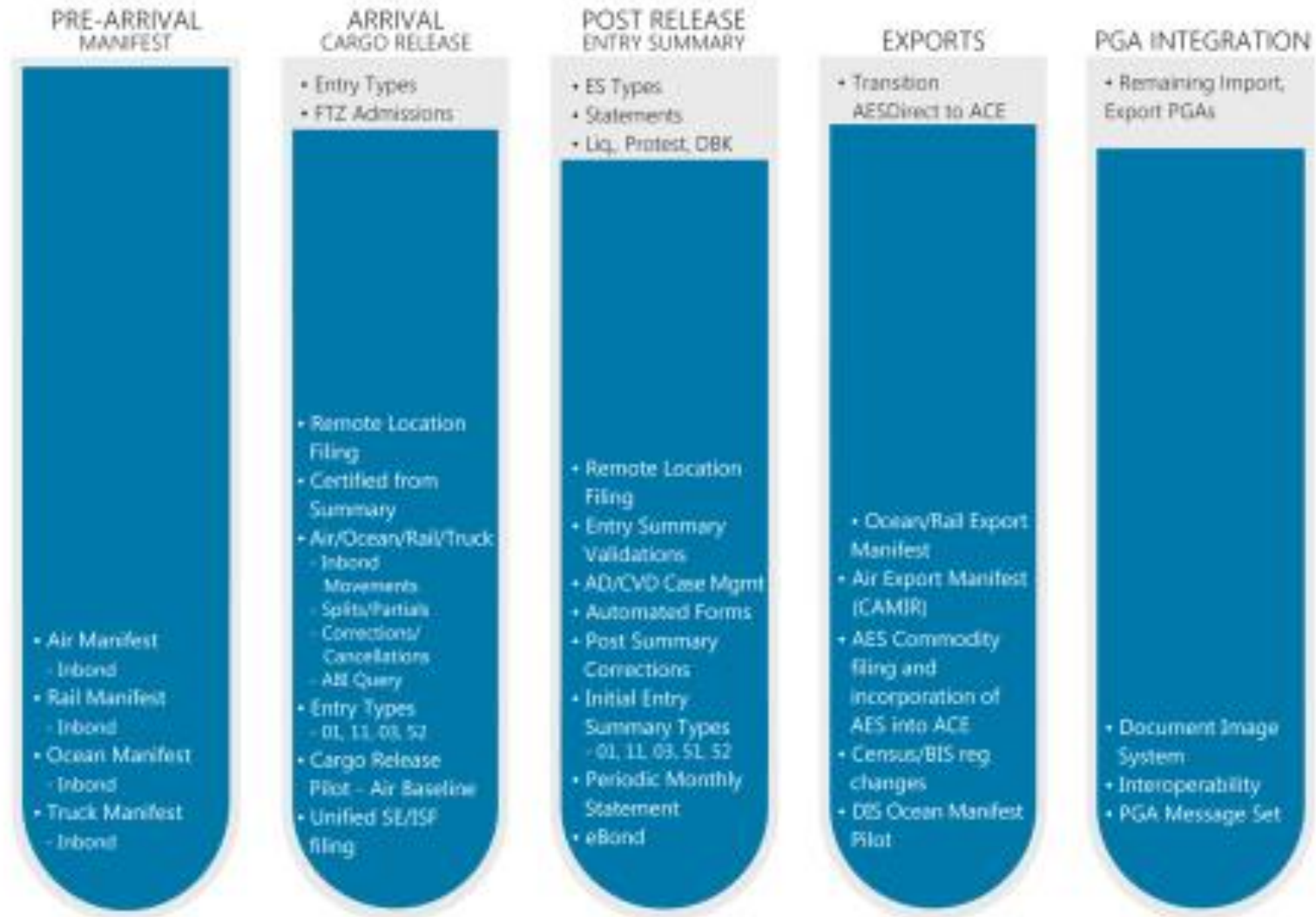

January 2015

May 20, 2015

Functionality for Nov. 1 delivered to CERT environment for trade testing

August 2015

Begin rollout of PGA pilot

May 1, 2015

ACE mandatory for all electronic manifest filings

November 1, 2015

Transition period begins: ACE filing of electronic entry and associated entry summary types 01, 03, 06, 11, 23, 51, 52 with or without PGA data is encouraged

March 31, 2016

Must be filed in ACE:

- Electronic entry summaries (Types 01, 03, 11, 23, 51, and 52) without PGA data
- Electronic entries/entry summaries with APHIS Lacey Act and NHTSA data

Summer 2016

Deployment and mandatory ACE filing:

- Electronic entry (Types 02, 07, 12, 21, 22) without PGA data

Functionality for filing electronic PGA data in ACE

February 28, 2016

CBP will start divesting the legacy Automated Commercial System (ACS)

May 28, 2016

Must be filed in ACE:

- Electronic entries (Types 01, 03, 11, 23, 51, and 52)
- Type 06 electronic entry and entry summaries without PGA data, except APHIS Lacey Act and NHTSA

October 1, 2016

ACE mandatory for all remaining electronic portions of the CBP cargo process



ACE 2016 Outlook

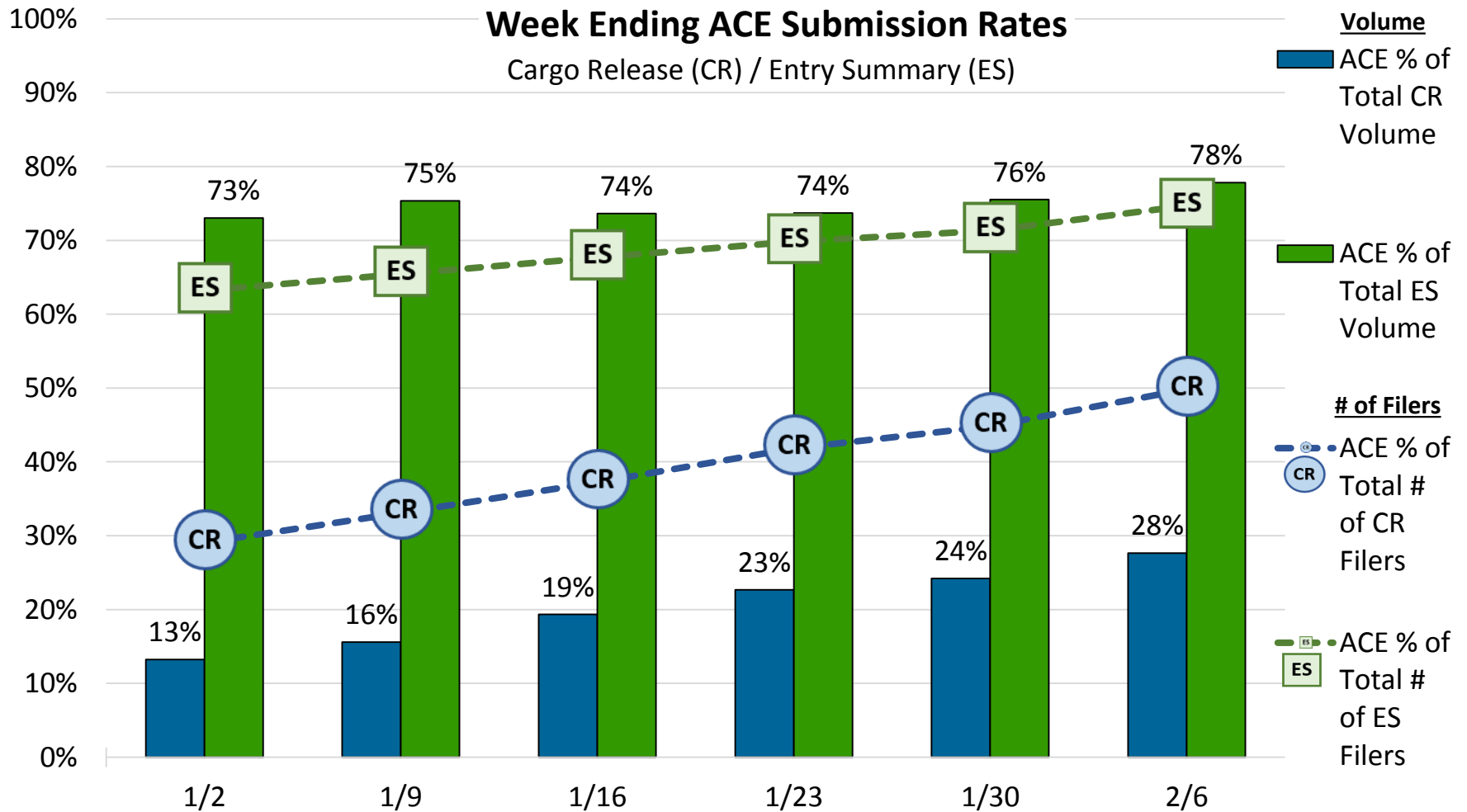
- Complete mandatory transition to ACE:
 - Mandatory filing of entry and entry summaries (March 31 through Summer 2016)
 - Mandatory use of ACE for all remaining portions of cargo processing
- Export activities:
 - Complete migration of AESDirect to ACE
 - AESPcLink and AESWeblink will be complete by end of April
 - Manifest pilots for air, rail and ocean will begin
 - Up to 9 participants each (combination of carriers and freight forwarders)
 - Truck pilot under consideration

Getting Ready for ACE

- As the mandatory dates draw near, make sure you have taken all the necessary steps.

Software Vendors and Self Filers

- Software configured to CATAIR guidelines on CBP.gov
- Software configured to supplemental PGA CATAIR guidelines on CBP.gov
- All capabilities tested in CERT
- Clients informed of software updates and aware of ACE transition

Brokers

- Software package from vendor is updated for ACE transition
- Entries have been filed in ACE Cargo Release successfully
- Entry Summaries have been filed in ACE successfully
- Confirm software vendor has successfully tested all capabilities in CERT
- Clients informed of software updates and aware of ACE transition

Importers

- Broker has updated software
- Broker can confirm that entries and entry summaries have been filed in ACE successfully (including new data elements for ACE entries/cargo release)




































ACE: EDI v Portal

Filing data with ACE:

- Submit import and export data in accordance with ACE technical standards through Electronic Data Interchange (EDI)

Once data is submitted to CBP, use the ACE Portal to:

- Evaluate compliance and monitor daily operations
- Access to more than 400 reports
- Submit truck import manifests
- Monitor data on file with CBP

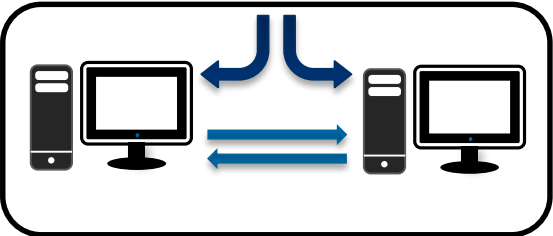


