



Trade Facilitation and Enforcement Bill

(Customs Reauthorization Bill)

June 23, 2016

On Feb. 24, President Obama signed into law a broad Customs reauthorization bill that includes many provisions on trade facilitation and enforcement.

The various provisions of the bill will impact both importers and customs brokers. This seminar will discuss how the new rules will benefit the importing community while strengthening Customs' enforcement tools.

As the title of the bill implies, the new legislation is intended to facilitate trade and improve processes for importers. At the same time, the law provides Customs & Border Protection with new tools to enforce existing and new regulations.
