- **Broker Known Importer** program that requires brokers to collect identifying information on their customers and fees for non-compliance
- **Centers of Expertise & Excellence (CEEs)** formalized as an “account based approach”
- **Trusted Trader** enhancements, consolidations and transparency in benefits
- **Importer Risk Assessment** program which is used to assess bonds
- **Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties** adjustments
