DID YOU KNOW THAT LITHIUM BATTERIES ARE DANGEROUS GOODS?

New Shipping Label Requirements for Items Containing Lithium Ion Batteries:

If you are shipping any of the following items, they will most likely contain Lithium Ion Batteries, (also known as Li-ion batteries).

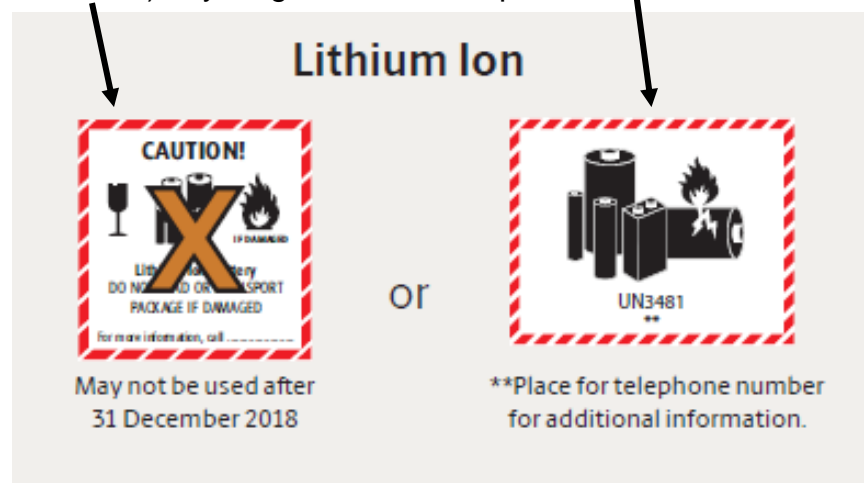
- Laptop Computers
- Cell Phones/iPhones
- Tablets/iPads
- MP3 Players/iPods
- Cameras/Video Cameras
- Power Tools
- Smart Watches
- Watches/Clocks
- Calculators
- Power bank chargers
- Flashlights

If unsure if the item contains Lithium Ion batteries, please contact the person who created the shipment to check.

If shipping Lithium Ion batteries separately, **DO NOT** use this label – please contact the Logistics Team.

Effective 2/1/2019 Li-ion batteries shipping without equipment CANNOT ship on a passenger flight.

There is a new shipping label required for all packages containing items with Lithium Ion batteries. The new label has **UN3481** on it (right picture below). Do not use the old label (left picture below) any longer for these shipments.



Ground Shipments of Items with Lithium Ion Batteries

All packages of Lithium ion batteries **packed with** OR **contained in** equipment require the UN3481 Lithium battery label.

A contact phone # (of the person who can provide information about the items being shipped) must be added to the label in space provided.

UPS Note: Ground service cannot be used for lithium battery shipments to **Alaska, Hawaii and Puerto Rico.**

Air Shipments of Lithium Ion Batteries **inside equipment:**

All packages of Lithium ion batteries **contained inside** the equipment being shipped, require the UN3481 Lithium battery label.

Also, the package(s) **must** be marked with the following: **P.I. 967-II**. (This indicates the batteries are **inside** the equipment).

A contact phone # (of the person who can provide information about the items being shipped) must be added to the label.

Air Shipments of Lithium Ion Batteries **packed with equipment**

All packages of "Lithium ion batteries **packed with** equipment" require the UN3481 Lithium battery label.

Also, the package(s) **must** be marked with the following: **P.I. 966-II**. (This indicates the batteries are in the box but not inside the equipment).

A contact phone # (of the person who can provide information about the items being shipped) must be written on the label.

Air Shipments weight limit of batteries:

Limit per package (excludes equipment): PAX = 5kg CAO = 35kg

If you are unsure of whether the batteries are contained **inside the equipment or **packed with** the equipment for air shipments, please check with the person shipping the item.**

Do not use envelopes or any other soft-sided packs when shipping items with Lithium Ion batteries.

The above instructions do not apply to shipping Lithium Ion batteries on their own (not with or inside equipment). Please see instructions below if shipping Li-on batteries alone.

New Shipping Label Requirements for Lithium Ion Batteries shipping alone:

All packages of “Lithium ion batteries shipping without equipment require a UN3480 Lithium battery label **AND** a *Cargo Aircraft Only* label.



Also, the package(s) **must** be marked with the following: **P.I. 965IA** or **P.I. 965IB**. (This indicates there are only batteries in the box and no equipment).

A contact phone # (of the person who can provide information about the items being shipped) **must be** written on the label.

The batteries must be shipped at a state of charge (SoC) not exceeding 30% of their rated capacity.

P.I. 965IA – Applies to Li-ion batteries that are greater than 100Wh. Weight limit per package = 35kg

P.I. 965IB – Applies to Li-ion batteries that equal or less than 100Wh. Weight limit per package = 10kg
