Analyzes changes to government regulations assessing impact on Ingram Micro on a global scale and implementing changes as appropriate. Ensures that reports required by the government are prepared accurately and submitted on time. Provides support to all internal and external customers with issues concerning compliance activities. Supports Legal and outside counsel in conducting trade compliance pre-acquisition due diligence. Designs automated processes to implement features of the control program in a systematic way wherever possible. Provides training to appropriate associates worldwide. Supports the development of IM Supply Chain Solutions business opportunities by counseling Sales and working on automated solutions to enhance our menu of services. Participates in customer contract negotiations and works with Legal to help define the terms and conditions related to fulfillment agreements.
