Job Description / Responsibilities / Requirements

The **Global Trade Analyst** will work with clients and IORs to coordinate and expedite shipments of overseas imports and exports in APAC, EMEA, and LATAM.

Overview of Responsibilities:

- Monitor import clearance and/or export delays and work with the IOR, Freight Forwarder/Courier and Client to resolve and clear Customs in a timely manner.
- Respond to inquiries regarding classification, duty rates, documentation and licensing requirements to ensure timely import clearance.
- As necessary, create and issue trade documents, including commercial invoices, certificate of origin, to support client shipments.
- Communicate shipping instructions with clients to ensure compliance.

- Provide trade compliance support regarding country of origin, marking, product valuation, and Incoterm usage.
- Provide guidance on Commercial Invoices, AWB's and other required Customs documentation.
- Review weekly IOR status report and ensure that all live order escalations are responded to in a timely manner.
- Work with Distribution Centers and GTS team to ensure import/export certificates and supporting documentation and licensing is in place prior to shipping.
- Maintain shipment status trackers of pending license approvals and/or other clearance delays.
- Coordinate EEI training, filing, and account maintenance with DC's.
- Assist in maintaining system of global trade product content and documentation.
- Oversee Choice system maintenances as related to global trade controls.
- Assist in projects (ie Country Maintenance overview, mass classification changes/updates, identifying Encryption information omitted from documents, etc.) and other tasks as assigned.
- Perform any additional projects or tasks as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- General Import/Export transaction / operational experience.
- Strong communication skills and cross cultural sensitivity to effectively guide clients through customs and compliance requirements.
- Working knowledge of EEI filing in ACE
- Well organized and able to manage multiple concurrent tasks.
