- Global Trade System (GTS) data entry - new material, material extensions, condition maintenance & other GTS related administration
- Handling blocked orders/deliveries in GTS (linked to Sanction Party List, Russian sanction or other blocks)
- Support New Product process - providing information to the brokers, update internal data and files
- Customs classification maintenance - checking regular updates to HS code changes
- Issue Long Term Supplier's Declaration (LTSD) to Customer from GTS
- Enter and maintain new Vendors' declarations into GTS
- Handling Russian Sanctions related administration for Samples procedures
- Data maintenance in different GTC SharePoint sites
- Authorized Exporter Status (AES) monitoring - compare broker's report with SAP/GTS data, report the results
- Monitor Authorized Economic Operator (AEO) related processes and administration on AEO related changes
- Administrative support of Inward Process Relief (IPR) calculations
- Import/Export reports collection, filing and reporting Duty Metrics
- Coordinating Power Of Attorney with Logistics and Legal department
- Administrative support of GTC yearly projects
- Participating GTC meetings/calls
