- Build a new trade compliance training package for distribution across the company
- Provide primary ownership of the company's Denied Parties Screening processes
- Further develop and cultivate subject matter expertise in various relevant trade compliance laws and regulations, including the ITAR, Export Administration Regulations, Office of Foreign Asset Control Regulations,

- U.S. Customs Regulations, ATF Regulations and applicable foreign trade control regulations
- Work with internal program personnel to support and facilitate their international export/import needs
 - Maintain records in accordance with applicable laws and regulations
 - Actively participate in the company's internal trade compliance audit program
 - Provide guidance and training to company personnel
 - Other trade compliance-related duties, as assigned

Requirements
