Our International Trade Compliance Department has been established to oversee and support our procedures and systems for trade compliance. The department's mission is to help develop and implement corporate, regional and country specific compliance programs and training materials for all employees who need to ensure trade compliance.

International trade compliance enables Dow to operate globally by:

- Managing and implementing compliance with international trade regulations and requirements for Dow goods (equipment, products, raw materials etc.) and technology.
- Analyzing and applying international trade techniques to provide Dow businesses with a competitive advantage.
- Providing international trade public policy advocacy to represent Dows' interest.
- The purpose of International Trade Operations is to comply with the trade laws, minimize duty payment and increase the supply chain speed and efficiencies.

Export Compliance:

The Compliance Manager will provide direction and counsel on the Export Process. Become an SME on the US Export regulations. Provide regulatory support for exports, liaisons with Government Agencies (Department of Commerce, Department of State, Department of Treasury, Drug Enforcement Agency, etc.) on behalf of The Dow Chemical Company businesses.

- Become a Subject Matter Expert on the Export Administration Regulations for the Deemed Export and Technology Export Compliance Program.
- Become a Subject Matter Expert on the International Traffic in Arms for the Deemed Export and Technology Export Compliance Program.
- Facilitate U.S. export control compliance of all Businesses and Functions for cross border movement of technology and people.
- Work closely with functions including Information Systems, Engineering Solutions, etc., to support Dow's continued business in emerging markets overseas (Intranet, servers, software, detailed specs, etc.) to ensure export compliance.
- Manage "deemed export program" through continued development/improvement, implementation and training on the process for foreign nationals (including visitors, contractors, employees, etc.) to have access to Dow U.S. facilities and technology, in compliance with the export control laws.

- Obtain necessary technology export licenses from various government agencies including, but not limited to, the U.S. Department of Commerce and U.S Dept. of State.
- Counsel the businesses on export control related matters concerning Joint Ventures (JV's) and obtain the necessary export authorizations from the government to facilitate those JV's.
- Continually work to enhance and improve the current export control processes and procedures in International Trade Operations.
- Continually work to enhance and improve the current import control processes and procedures in International Trade Operations.

#### Qualifications

- Bachelors degree is required
- Minimum of 5 years of work experience in Export compliance
- A minimum requirement for this U.S. based position is the ability to work legally in the United States. No visa sponsorship/support is available for this position, including for any type of U.S. permanent residency (green card) process.
