Primary Responsibilities

- Collaborate cross-functionally to ensure compliance with all relevant trade related laws and regulations while enabling the business to achieve objectives
- Post Entry audits of all Customs Brokers
- Assist in developing Export compliance program
- Manage local (HTSUS) Harmonize Tariff Schedule classifications for components and finished goods; submit database and required documentation to appropriate parties
- Manage Broker requests to ensure timeliness and accuracy of all entries submitted to Customs
- Assist in overseeing Value Reconciliation Process
- Create local work instructions and provide related training
- Assist with implementing and maintaining Duty Drawback program
- Assist with the internal auditing of all import/export activities
