- **Organize monitoring and audit of customs clearance processes and documentation to ensure compliance with trade laws.**
- **Advising business on compliance requirements and related controls.**
- **Creating, assessing, and implementing Standard Operating Procedures (SOP from scratch.**
- **Identify and drive cost management and duty optimization activities.**
- **Identify and integrate 'best practices' standards for the organization based on global cooperation.**
- **Build partnerships with third-party customs brokerage firms, government agencies, trade compliance service providers.**
